A message from Principal Kelley

Overwhelming evidence indicates that student success is directly related to regular student attendance. Poor attendance refers to students who are absent as well as to students who are tardy or leave school prior to the end of the school day. High performing students have an average of less than three days absent or tardy in a school year.

At South Woods, we continue to strive for excellence with our students and staff. Currently our school has among the highest absenteeism rate in the school district. Because student attendance has such an impact on student performance, we will continue to take action to support good attendance.

This year, beginning on Wednesday, September 6, 2017, any tardy student who has more than one unexcused tardy a quarter, will be required to serve lunch detention by sitting apart from his or her class in the lunch room the day following the tardy. If a parent feels it is his or her fault a student is tardy, the parent is welcome to serve the detention in place of his or her child. A tardy is considered excused with a note from a doctor's office on the morning of the appointment. Remember, students who ride the bus will never be considered tardy.

Tardiness not only has a negative impact on the late student, but it also has a negative impact on all students in the classroom. Each time a student comes in tardy, the teacher stops instruction to address the student, updates the student record, updates the class lunch count and provides direction to the student regarding the current lesson. Even if each student in a class was tardy only once a quarter, there would be a minimum of 72 interruptions to student learning in each class during the most valuable learning time of the day.

Student absenteeism will be addressed through daily automated calls, five and ten day notification letters, and scheduled parent meetings. Parents of students who have excessive absenteeism will be referred to the proper authorities for action as directed by St. Johns County School District policy.

To support positive attendance, students who have perfect attendance (no absences, no tardies and no early check outs) will be recognized each quarter during our grade level honors ceremony.

i-Ready assessment

Our school has implemented a program called *i*-Ready[®] Diagnostic, an innovative adaptive assessment program for Reading and Math. *i*-Ready will help teachers assess the needs of each and every student in their class while monitoring progress throughout the school year.

i-Ready Diagnostic will be given three times during the school year: at the beginning of the school year, middle of the year, and end of the year. The results of the adaptive assessment provide teachers with an instructional course of action personalized for each student.

An adaptive assessment is:

- Designed for students to get about 50% correct and 50% incorrect and will find a "just right" placement level for reading and/or mathematics for each student in the quickest, most efficient way possible.
- Helpful in showing what your child "can do" and what "the next steps" should be, individualizing for each student.

I would like to enlist your assistance in preparing your child for this assessment. **Please encourage your child to:**

- Eat a good breakfast and be rested for the day of the assessment
- Try their best on each question and try not to rush
- Try not to worry about questions they do not know—remind them that it is expected they will get about half of the questions correct
- Take "breaks" and have fun with the short "game breaks" that are integrated into the assessment
- Have paper and pencil handy for math questions
- Be respectful of other students who take longer to finish
