

From Principal Kelley:

I would like to update our parents and families on the Community Partnership School initiative that is under way here at South Woods Elementary. This process has been in the works for more than a year and we have recently appointed a Community School Director, Mr. Chris Stone. Mr. Stone comes to the South Woods team by way of the St. Johns County School District's Student Services department. He has held various positions with local nonprofits and boards, all with a focus on serving families and students. Mr. Stone is a resident of the Elkton community where he lives with his wife Kendra who is a teacher at Gamble Rogers Middle School and two year old daughter Adeline.

What is a Community Partnership School & Why South Woods Elementary?

We are fortunate enough to have four core partners (St. Johns County Schools, Flagler Hospital, St. Johns River State College & Children's Home Society) that have agreed to step in and address the needs of the communities that South Woods Elementary serves. South Woods Elementary was selected due to having one of the highest percentage of students enrolled in the free and reduced meals program throughout the St. Johns County School District. Families and students that attend South Woods Elementary have unique challenges with access to social service programs and resources that are typically available in other communities. The households that are zoned for South Woods Elementary are among one of the most diverse student groups due to the region that the school serves. Students from rural and farm communities all the way to the coastal regions of St. Johns County make up the student population. The long term vision for South Woods Community Partnership School would be to offer essential services to students, families and community members in the areas of medical, dental, mental health as well as many others. The services will be located on campus at South Woods in order to help remove many of the barriers that our students and families experience. We are currently undertaking the needs assessment and strategic planning process by collecting data from community members in the form of surveys and focus groups. This will let our community provide input into what services they feel will make the most impact on not only their child's education, but for the entire household and community.
