School Tardy Policy to Change in 2017-2018

Did you know that tardiness has a negative impact on student performance? In fact, many of our students that are performing below level have been tardy five or more time this school year. Tardiness not only negatively impacts the late student, but it also has a negative impact on all students in the classroom. Each time a student who is tardy enters the classroom, the teacher must stop instruction to address the student which decreases the amount of valuable instruction time.

To address this concern, beginning in the 2017-2018 school year, students who are tardy more than once a quarter will be required to serve lunch detention. If a parent feels it is his or her fault a student is tardy, the parent is welcome to serve the detention in place of his or her child. Remember, students who ride the bus to school every day will never be marked tardy.
