## A message from Mrs. Ambrose, South Woods Guidance Counselor

Within the first hour of returning to work following Hurricane Irma, the staff of South Woods gathered to take stock of our school community. Our teachers made phone calls to each of their students' families, to assess their needs and offer support. When the students returned to school the following week, a survey went home with every child to determine what our families needed and help set a course of action. We wanted to make sure all of our families in the South Woods community knew we were there to help. As the School Counselor, I was able to coordinate our support with the help of Christopher Stone, our Community School director and over 25 volunteers.

I was in awe at the generosity of our community. Word spread quickly of how devastated some of our families were and the donations poured in. We received over \$1000 of food from Memorial Presbyterian Church. Patriot Oaks Elementary School did a donation drive for us. A parent, whose child attends RB Hunt Elementary School, conducted a donation drive for us as well. Hugs Across the County provided toiletry items and the Girl Scouts donated bags and boxes of goods. Many staff members took action by collecting donations and as well as lending support to efforts in the community. Many of our South Woods students' families collected donations as well. We even heard from schools as far away as Maine who offered help and support.

Hurricane Irma was a damaging storm that affected us all. Whether your family was in a position to give, or receive, we all learned the power and strength of coming together as one caring community.
